**ENTRY & PURSE INFORMATION**

1. \$20.00 ENTRY FEE PER CAR (INCLUDES DRIVER'S PIT PASS).
2. **MECHANICS PIT FEE \$10.00**
3. Drivers may enter more than one heat, but must have a different car for each heat.
4. The Kosciusko County Community Fair, Inc. reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
5. The decision of the judges will be final.
6. Twenty (20) cars will make feature. \$25.00 will be paid to all cars making feature. **A car must start feature to be paid.**

**Top Five Positions will be paid**

Purse: 1<sup>st</sup> \$600.00  
2<sup>nd</sup> \$300.00  
3<sup>rd</sup> \$200.00  
4<sup>th</sup> \$100.00  
5<sup>th</sup> \$ 50.00

**Outlaw Class**

OPEN RULES  
Must have safety equipment  
**Must have a minimum of ten (10 entries)**  
Purse: Winner \$1,000.00  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$500.00  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$250.00

**DRIVERS & PIT INFORMATION:**

1. All drivers must supply their own car.
2. All drivers must have photo I.D.
3. Each driver must be 18 years of age or older. Youth under eighteen (18), must supply a notarized release form signed by parent/guardian and submit along with the application to Fair Office *at least one week* prior to Derby requesting approval.
4. **ONLY OWNERS, DRIVERS AND MECHANICS will be permitted in the pit area. MUST HAVE POSSESSION OF PIT PASS.**
5. The use of intoxicating substances prior to, during, or after the Derby DISQUALIFIES the driver, car and crew of the offending party.
6. **SEAT BELTS, 1995 OR NEWER, D.O.T. APPROVED HELMETS, AND NECK COLLARS ARE MANDATORY.**
7. Any driver/crew not obeying the rules will be disqualified.
8. Powder Puff will run last. Sign up available until five (5) minutes before the event. No Outlaw Cars.

**PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS**

1. Driver may maneuver forward or backward.
2. No deliberate head-on hitting driver's door.
3. All drivers must attend driver's meeting, approximately ½ to one hour before start of Derby.
4. Driver must remain in car until removed by tow truck.
5. Do not play possum. No team driving. Contact must be made every forty-five (45) seconds. No love taps.
6. Boundaries must be observed.
7. The last two, three, and four (2/3/4) active cars in each heat shall comprise the feature.
8. No compact cars. Minimum wheel base 104".
9. Any car spilling fuel or catching on fire is automatically disqualified.

**PREPARATION OF CAR:**

1. All cars must be 1965 or newer. No hearses, vans, trucks, Jeeps, El Caminos, or Imperials. No compact cars. Minimum wheel base 104". **CARS MAY HAVE RUN IN OTHER DERBIES. SUBJECT TO TECH INSPECTIONS FINAL APPROVAL.**
2. Any stock hardtop sedan automobile or station wagon is allowed.
3. No foul language, vulgar comments, or graffiti is allowed on cars. Inspector's decision is final. Slogans, advertising or printing may be placed on car (except driver's door).
4. Driver's door must be painted WHITE.

5. Batteries may be placed in a secure position in the passenger compartment, but must be completely covered and securely strapped to the floor. Marine battery boxes are recommended.
6. All glass, plastic moldings and chrome molding, light holders, plastic plugs, etc. (anything that may damage tires) must be removed before reaching the fairgrounds.
7. No special bumpers, extra weights, trailer hitches, special lifts, blocks, shackles or any reinforcement.
8. No oversized tires. No liquid of any kind in tires. All tires must be tubeless **15" D.O.T. approved passenger tires**, with nothing inside the tires. No truck tires.
9. All cars must be empty of debris, spare parts, etc.
10. All doors and tailgates must be welded or chained shut. Weld using no more than two (2), two inch by four inch (2" X 4") straps, horizontal, per door.
11. A twelve-inch (12") hole, in diameter, should be cut in the top of the hood and trunk lid. Hood and trunk latches should be removed and hood and trunk wired so it can be cut in case of fire. Hood and trunk lids are **not** to be chained or welded.
12. Cars must have brakes before beginning heat.
13. Any car spilling fuel or catching on fire is automatically disqualified.
14. Steel rods or chains can replace windshield to prevent debris from entering the passenger compartment. Window screening material is optional.
15. Stock gas tank must be removed. Gas tank must be moved to inside of the car in rear seat area and mounted securely with steel straps. Use of fuel cells is recommended.
16. A firewall is required to separate the gas tank area from the passenger compartment.
17. Cars must start and move out on the track under own power. **NO PUSHING ONTO TRACK.**
18. All fuel injected cars or cars with electric fuel pumps must have a shut-off switch on dash in front of driver in case of fire.
19. Radiators must be in stock location and functional. Water only in radiators, no anti-freeze or other liquids.
20. Front and rear bumper may be wired to hood and trunk lid. Maximum of two (2) wires in three (3) places to hood, and two (2) wires in three (3) places to trunk lid. No side lacing.
21. Bumper must be in stock location, and attached by stock fasteners.
22. No welding of frame seams, bumper shocks, and bumper brackets.
23. No notching frames, cutting or denting deck lids on roofs.
24. Suspension must be in working order. Meaning no air shocks, spring stiffeners, or modified springs.
25. Any modifications can be done that does not increase the structural integrity, to insure driver safety will be allowed. A simple four-post cage must be welded to the frame.
26. Welded rear-end gears are OK.
27. Valve stem guards are OK.
28. Please, **NO** previous numbered cars. Numbers will be assigned at tech inspections.
29. Vehicles will be inspected. **ALL** winners (except Outlaw Class) will be inspected after the race. This includes frames, suspensions, and radiators.
30. The winning car may be protested for a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) protest fee within ten (10) minutes after the final heat.
31. Derby Officials may impose rules as necessary for safety and fairness of participants and spectators.
32. **ALL OFFICIAL RULINGS ARE FINAL.**
